1. Description

Prints out properties.

This command reads the information generated by [Get-Properties](#) command and prints it to the console using the specified format.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t Managed-Entity -o <objectname> -c Properties [-detail]
[-file <>] [-format <pretty>]
```

2.1. Options

Option	Description	Type	Default
detail	<i>print more detail</i> This flag works in conjunction with the <code>-format pretty</code> flag and signifies to show properties besides those of this entity.	boolean	
file	<i>file containing property data</i>	string	<code>\${entity.properties.file}</code>
format	<i>output format. pretty or plain</i> Two formats are defined: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> pretty: This format signifies to make the information suitable for human interpretation. plain: When plain is specified the content of the file are printed directly without any adornment. 	string	pretty
