## 1. Description

*replace string*

Replace is a directory based command for replacing the occurrence of a given string with another string.

*static:* This command can be run outside of an object context.

## 2. Usage

```
ctl -m textutil -c replace -basedir <> [-exts
<.xml,.properties,.txt,.rdf,.html,.template,.conf>] [-filebase
<*>] -token <> -value <>
```

<b>basedir</b>	<i>directory to search</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.basedir}</code>
<b>exts</b>	<i>comma-separated list of extensions to search</i>	string	<code>.xml,.properties,.txt,.rdf,.ht</code>
<b>filebase</b>	<i>filename minus extension</i>	string	<code>*</code>
<b>token</b>	<i>token to find</i>	string	
<b>value</b>	<i>string to replace token with</i>	string
