### 5.1. extract

*extracts the distribution*

extracts the package into the \$JBOSS\_HOME/server/<jboss\_server\_config> directory

#### Usage

extract [-filename <>] [-installroot <>]

#### Options

Option	Description
filename	<i>filename of the distribution</i> filename representing the package distribution
installroot	<i>destination directory</i> installation root of the package
