1. Description

Confirm the package process is installed.

The assertPackageUnInstalled command is a hook command overridden by subtypes providing a package specific check to determine if the package is not installed.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t Package -o <objectname> -c assertPackageIsUnInstalled
[-executable <>] [-installroot <>] [-script <>]
```

executable	<i>executable to run</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.package-isu</code>
installroot	<i>root where package files reside</i>	string	<code>\${entity.package-install-root}</code>
script	<i>script to execute</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.package-isu</code>
