

find-objects

Command Reference

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1. Description

Query project for objects matching query params.

This command is used to query the active model on the server for any objects matching the option specifications and saves the result in a session that can be used by [purge-objects](#).

Example: Find all objects of zip type:

```
ctl -p project -m ProjectBuilder -c find-objects --\
    -type zip
```

static: This command can be run outside of an object context.

2. Usage

```
ctl -m ProjectBuilder -c find-objects [-name <.*>] [-purge]
[-session <find.session>] [-type <Managed-Entity>] [-useregex
<true>]
```

2.1. Options

Option	Description	Type	Default
name	<i>object name (or regex)</i>	string	. *
purge	<i>purge found objects</i>	boolean	
session	<i>session name</i>	string	find.session
type	<i>object type name (or regex)</i>	string	Managed-Entity
useregex	<i>Use regexes to match object name and type</i>	string	true
