1. Description

Purge unused and not-current packages.

The Purge command finds the set of package objects associated with the provided package type and/or buildstamp (or buildstamp regex) and deletes them from the repository and the object model that are not in use and are not associated with the most recent build (per `entity.attribute.buildstamp`).

2. Usage

```
ctl -t Builder -o <objectname> -c Purge [-buildertype <>]
[-buildstamp <>] [-packagetype <>]
```

Option	Description	Type	Default
buildertype	<i>builder type</i>	string	<code>\${context.type}</code>
buildstamp	<i>build identifier (regex allowed)</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.packagePurge}</code>
packagetype	<i>type (or subtype) of package to find</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.packageType}</code>
