1. Description

Find package objects in the repository.

The repoFind command queries the project model maintained in the server for packages that match -packagetype, -version and/or -buildstamp. All results are stored in a named session.

If the -purge option is specified, the results will be passed as input to the [repoPurge](#) for removal from the repository.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t Builder -o <objectname> -c repoFind [-builddertype <>]
[-buildstamp <.*>] [-buildtime <.*>] [-packagename <.*>]
[-packagetype <>] [-purge] [-session <repoFind.session>]
```

2.1. Options

Option	Description	Type	Default
builddertype	<i>builder type</i>	string	<code> \${context.type}</code>
buildstamp	<i>build identifier (regex allowed)</i>	string	<code>.*</code>
buildtime	<i>build time of packages to find (regex allowed)</i>	string	<code>.*</code>
packagename	<i>name of package to find</i>	string	<code>.*</code>
packagetype	<i>type (or subtype) of package to find</i>	string	<code> \${entity.attribute.packageType}</code>
purge	<i>run repoPurge using results of find</i>	boolean	
session	<i>store results in session</i>	string	<code>repoFind.session</code>
