1. Description

Install the configured package dependencies for the deployment.

The Packages-Install command iterates over all the package object dependencies declared in the object context, and for each one, calls [Package](#)'s Install command.

It is possible to only install packages of a certain type using the `-resourceType` option.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t Deployment -o <objectname> -c Packages-Install
[-buildstamp <>] [-packageproximity <1>] [-resourcetype
<[^\.]*>]
```

2.1. Options

| Option | Description | Type | Default |
|------------------|------------------------------------------------------------|--------|----------------------------------------|
| buildstamp | <i>build identifier. currently ignored</i> | string | |
| packageproximity | <i>package resource proximity</i> | string | 1 / \${entity.attribute.defaultPack |
| resourcetype | <i>type name or type name regex of packages to install</i> | string | [^\.]* |
