1. Description

Extract the package archive.

Extracts the web archive file into the install root directory. If `-base` is also specified, the extraction will occur in `${opts.installroot} / ${opts.base}`.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t war -o <objectname> -c extract [-base <>] -filename <>
[-filtersfile <>] -installroot <> [-script <>] [-unpack <>]
-url <>
```
