1. Description

asynchronously executes the jboss start command

standard startService command to asynchronously start the jboss server instance.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t JBossServer -o <objectname> -c startService [-basedir
<>] [-host <0.0.0.0>] [-install_root <>] [-java_home <>]
[-spawn <>true>]
```

2.1. Options

| Option | Description | Type | Default |

| basedir | <i>base directory of the jboss instance</i> | string | <code>\${entity.attribute.jboss_basedir}</code> |
| host | <i>defines which interface(s) to bind to, 0.0.0.0 defaults to all interfaces</i> | string | <code>0.0.0.0 / \${entity.attribute.jboss_host}</code> |
| install_root | | string | <code>\${entity.attribute.jboss_install_root}</code> |
| java_home | <code>JAVA_HOME</code> | string | <code>\${entity.attribute.java_home}</code> |
| spawn | <i>Whether or not to run in background</i> | string | true |
