## 1. Description

*Check whether the Java Service Wrapper Windows service is not installed*

Queries the state of the Windows service using the Java Service Wrapper software, and fails if the state is "installed".

## 2. Usage

```
ctl -t JavaServiceWrapper -o <objectname> -c
assertServiceIsNotInstalled [-installroot <>] [-packagebase
<>] [-servicename <>]
```

installroot	<i>Java wrapper service wrapper home directory</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.installRoot}</code>
packagebase	<i>Java wrapper service wrapper package installation directory</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.javaService}</code>
servicename	<i>Java wrapper service wrapper Windows service name</i>	string	<code>\${entity.attribute.javaService}</code>
