1. Description

executes a command

static: This command can be run outside of an object context.

ctl -m Deployment -c exec [-argline <>] -executable <>
[-failonerror <true>] [-os <>] [-output <>] [-script <>]
[-scriptfile <>] [-scripturl <>] -strategy <shellutil>
[-timeout <>]
```

Option	Description	Type	Default
argline	<i>arguments for executable</i>	string	
executable	<i>executable path</i>	string	
failonerror	<i>fail if there is an error</i>	string	true
os	<i>list of Operating Systems on which the command may be executed.</i>	string	
output	<i>Name of a file to which to write the output. If the error stream is not also redirected to a file or property, it will appear in this output.</i>	string	
script	<i>script to execute</i>	string	
scriptfile	<i>scriptfile to execute</i>	string	
scripturl	<i>URL of a script to execute, supporting the dav:// protocol</i>	string	
strategy	<i>strategy module</i>	string	shellutil
timeout	<i>Stop the command if it</i>	string
