1. Description

Start the service process.

The startService command is a hook command overridden by subtypes providing a service specific procedure to bring the service into a running state.

2. Usage

```
ctl -t Service -o <objectname> -c startService [-executable
<>] [-script <>] [-spawn <>]
```

2.1. Options

| Option | Description | Type | Default |
|------------|--|--------|--|
| executable | <i>executable to run</i> | string | <code>\${entity.attribute.service-sta</code> |
| script | <i>script to execute</i> | string | <code>\${entity.attribute.service-sta</code> |
| spawn | <i>whether to spawn the script execution</i> | string | <code>\${entity.attribute.service-spa</code> |
